

## **Leilakul (3520m) – Tagobikul (2580m)**

**Distance:** 17km

**Ascent:** 390m

**Descent:** 1330m

**Trail:** moderate – snow fields and variable trails

### **Accommodation**

#### **Camping**

From the camp spot, that's a little further towards the pass than the actual Leilakul Lakes, it's a short but steep climb up the Akhbakul Pass. Note that there is another pass (Leilakul Pass, 3850m) slightly further south, dropping into the Leilakul Valley. The Akhbakul Pass bends towards the northeast and following the north flowing Tagobikul River. Descend on the left side of the valley next to the small glacier. Early in the season a snowfield goes down quite a long way. At around 3400m cross to the right bank (the river is subterranean here) and cross back again at 3100m. From here it's easy cruising on a good path down to the camp at 2580m, where the approach starts for the Qul Pass.
