

Alaudin Lake (2800m) – Mutnyi Lake (3530m)

Distance: 5km

Ascent: 730m

Descent: 0m

Trail: easy – clear trails

Camping

There are some spots for camping, though it's quite rocky around this area. Mutnyi means mud and the murky water of the small lake is unsuitable for drinking. Find a stream in the vicinity.

The hike to Mutnyi is pretty straightforward. The terrain becomes quite rocky as you get above the treeline. It's again a short stage due to altitude gain and the big pass (Chimtarga, 4750m) the next stage. It's a great camp to admire the 5000m+ peaks around here.
