Tagobikul (2580m) – Tagrich (3030m)

Distance: 12km

Ascent: 1100m

Descent: 650m

Trail: moderate – clear trails

Accommodation

Camping

Head west on a clear trail to the village of Qul. This is one of the remotest settlements in the Yagnob Valley! Cross the first small bridge at the entrance of the village and find the trail up where the village ends. The trail is mostly clear, only fading occasionally. It winds its way up to a shepherd camp at 3100 metres. The trail becomes more of a livestock trail, contouring for a little bit before ascending again at the stream crossing (where you should stock up on water, this is the last water source for a while). The last kilometre is again contouring around the slopes to reach the Qul Pass. From there it's pretty much straight west to the Tagrich River. This is a great spot to camp with grass, clean water and amazing views of the Zamin Karor Massif.
